"With the unwavering support of growers, volunteers and donors we delivered over **40,000 lbs.** of fruit and vegetables to those in need in Central Pennsylvania. More than half of this was fruit harvested by our dedicated volunteers, which made a wonderful addition to the 16 different vegetables grown by 6 different gardeners/farmers. And none of this would have been possible without the money donated by 50+ donors for the seeds, supplies and equipment to keep our operation running. Ninety percent of the harvest was provided to Centre County food banks and pantries, all of which expressed gratitude for the quantity and variety of donations.


Thank you for your volunteerism and contributions this year!
